



Rebula Robida 2013 (Zorjena)

Slovenia, Plesivo, Goriska Brda ZGP

Light Orange (gold-yellow) wine

grapes: *Rebula (100%) aka Ribolla gialla in Italy*

age of plant: *45 years and 9 years*

position of the plant: *Brda/South west*

soil: *limestone*

harvest: *manual picking and selection in boxes*

vinification: *3 days maceration at natural temperature and yeast*

ageing: *3 years in big used oak barrels*

production: *5600 bottles/year*

filtering: *unfiltered*

type: *a mature dry white wine*

bottled: *November 2016*

ph: *3,64*

total acidity (gr/lt): *4,84*

residual suger (gr/lt): *1,7*

alcohol content: *13 %vol*

serving temperature: *10^o-12^oC*

pairing: *fish, seafood, trout, pasta with vegetables*

description: *Robida is the name of the winery from which this wine is made. Chosen grapes are picked by hand. It has an intense gold-yellow color. A rich and mature smell of ripe fruit, spicy and dry flowers. In the mouth it is elegant with calm acid, balanced mineral and nice harmonious aftertaste.*
